## Revision of Minimum Rates of Wages

The Central Government in exercise of the powers conferred under Clause (b) of section 3 read with clause (i) of sub-section (1) of section 4 of the minimum wages Act, 1948 has revised the minimum rates of wages per day for all category of employees specified in column no. (1) of the Gazette Notification S.O.No. 187(E) for the Schedule Employment of Gypsum Mines, Barytes Mines, Bauxite Mines, Manganese Mines, China Clay Mines, Kyanite Mines, Copper Mines, Clay Mines, Magnesite Mines, White Clay Mines, Stone Mines, Steatite Mines (including the mines producing Soap Stones and Talc), Ochre Mines, Asbestos Mines, Fire Clay Mines, Chromite Mines, Quartzite Mines, Quartz Mines, Silica Mines, Graphite Mines, Felspar Mines, Laterite Mines, Dolomite Mines, Red Oxide Mines, Wolfram Mines Iron Ore Mines, Granite Mines Rock Phosphate Mines, Hematite Mines, Marble and Calcite Mines, Uranium Mines, Mica Mines, Lignite Mines, Gravel Mines, Slate Mines and Magnetite Mines which is effective from the date of publication i.e. 19th January, 2017. The revised rates of minimum wages per day is given below.

Skilled/ clerical	523	610
Highly Skilled	610	683

The workers are eligible for the minimum wages quoted against their respective category and next VDA shall be effective from 01.04.2017 only.
